GETTING TO AND FROM STAVANGER

Stavanger is within easy access with a well developed infrastructure for both national and international travelers. Most visitors travel to Stavanger by air. Stavanger Airport, Sola is situated 15 km from downtown Stavanger.

Boreal operates an airport transfer service from Stavanger Airport Sola to Stavanger Forum and downtown Stavanger. Departure every 20 minutes

Fjordline operates with one daily departure and arrival from Stavanger to Hirtshals, Denmark, and is the largest cruise ferry to use single fueled LNG engines.

TRANSPORTATION IN AND AROUND STAVANGER

Stavanger is a compact city with a pedestrian city center, and all amenities are within a short walking distance. For each hotel and venue outside of Stavanger, the city has a well developed efficient and environmental friendly bus system, run by Kolumbus.
